Habitat for Humanity is an international organization devoted to building "simple, decent, and affordable" housing. Homes are built using volunteer labor and are sold at no profit. Annually, the Paterson Habitat for Humanity has a two-week Corporate Challenge community service program, where corporations from the tri-state area donate funds and send employee volunteers to work on a building project.
